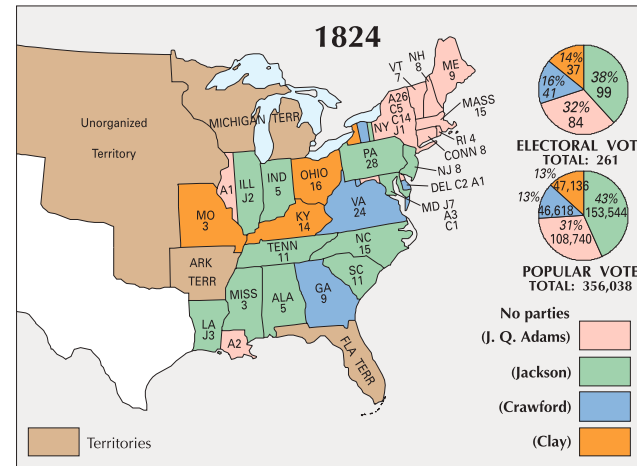
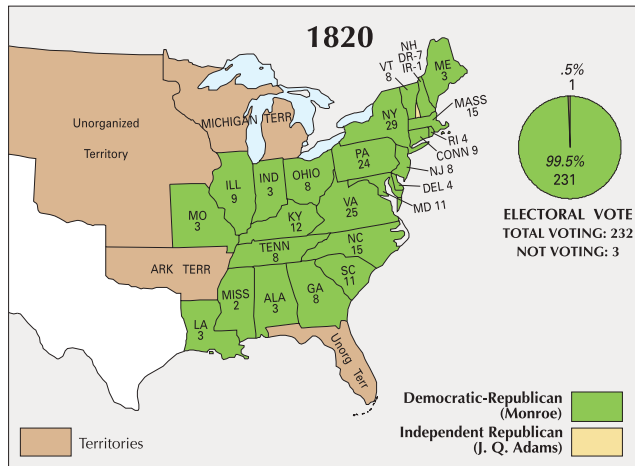
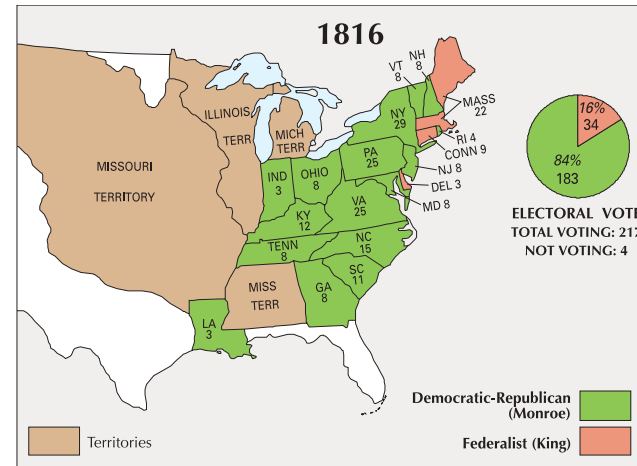
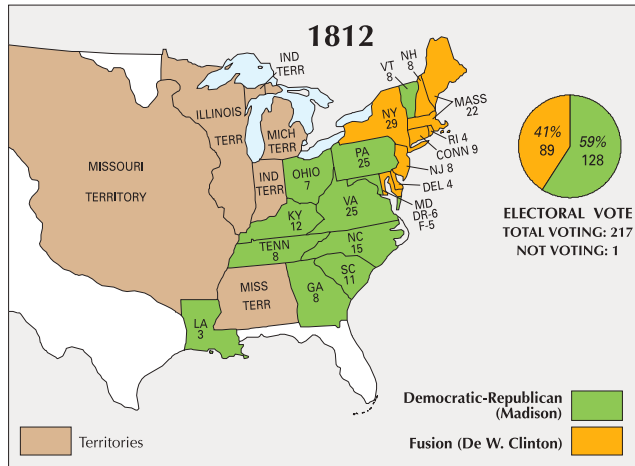
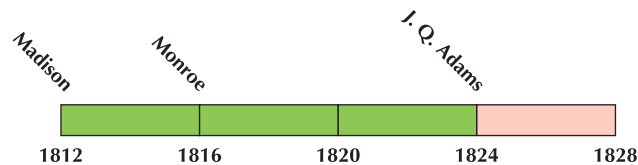


PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS 1812-1824
