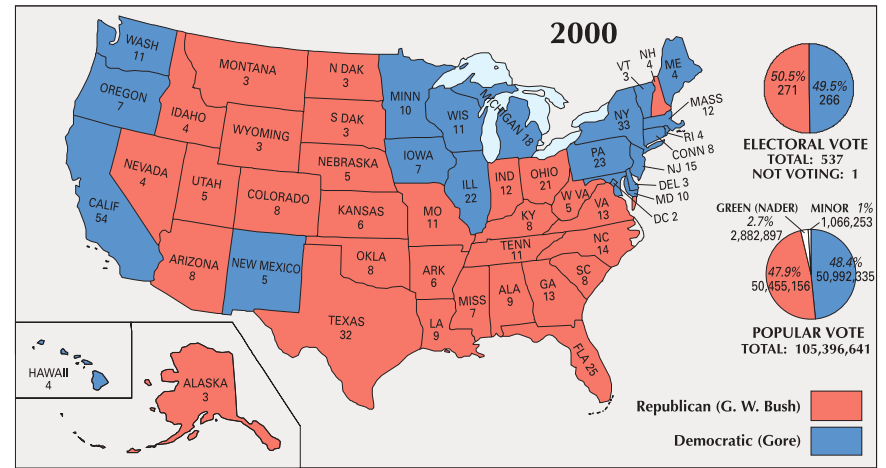
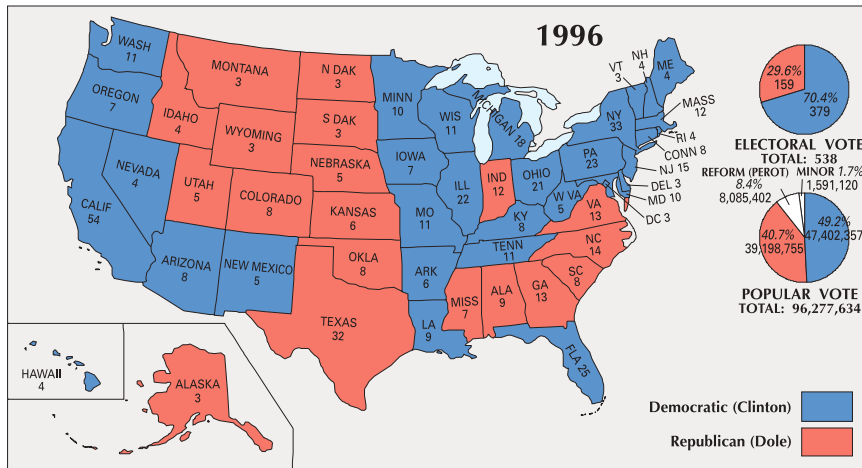
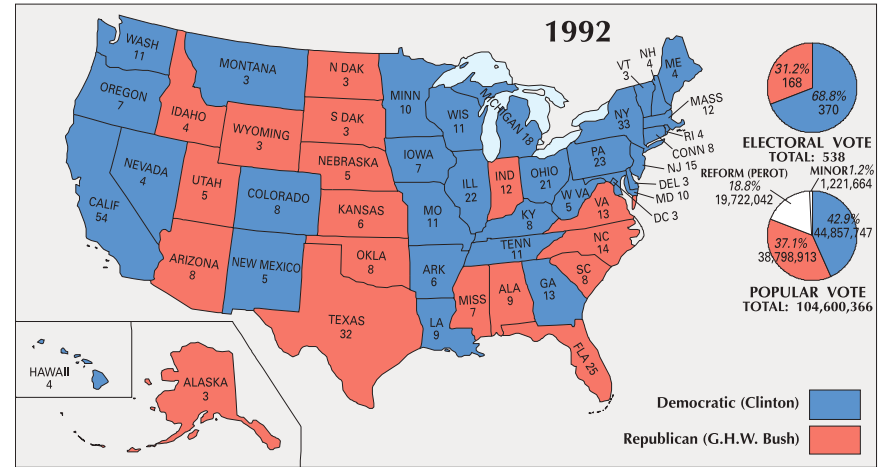
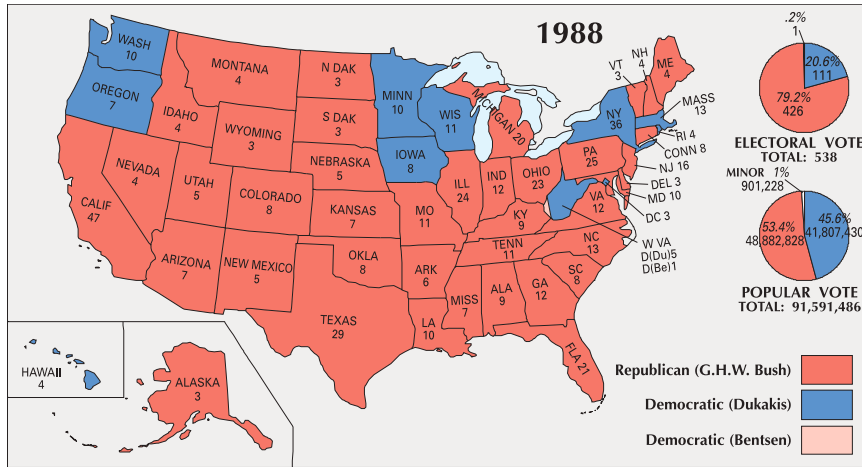
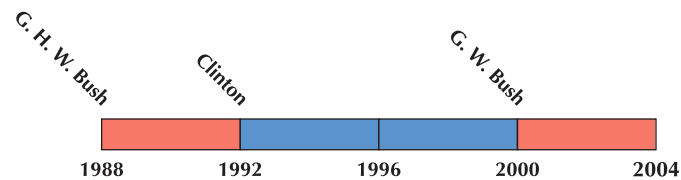


PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS 1988-2000
